Agency Hiring 10 Positions in Healthcare and Counseling

Clearwater, FL (June 23rd, 2011). Directions for Mental Health is bringing its nationally accredited health care services to Pasco County and hiring 10 new positions. The agency, which has three offices in Pinellas County, will offer outpatient mental health services at its brand-new Pasco County office, located at 5642 Meadowlane Street in New Port Richey. The office will open for services on August 1st, and job applications are being accepted now. Open positions are in psychiatry and counseling.

Directions for Mental Health is one of the largest not-for-profit behavioral health organizations in Pinellas County and will bring nearly 30 years of experience to Pasco County. Directions currently employs over 220 staff and serves over 10,000 people each year. The agency expects to increase the number of individuals served by 20% over the next year with this expansion.
